- 2. Promoting the Right to Farm Law recently passed- new signage welcoming travelers into Town of York- add a Right to Farm Community to signs- or something like this- also a poster for the Town Hall would be good- Heather will be looking into sign- estimates etc...
- 3. Apply for the grant- Mr. Deuel will continue working on this aspect

More discussion of long term goals- farmers' market etc...
