APPLICATIONS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION

OWNER CHECK LIST

- 1. Must obtain a building permit.
- 2. If parcel is part of municipal water and/or sewer, tap applications may be obtained at the York Town Office. If not part of municipal system, the owner MUST APPLY THROUGH THE LIVINGSTON County Department of Health, 243-7280, for procedures. Once approval has been made by the Health Department, a copy of it must be submitted with the building permit application.
- 3. Contact the York Highway Superintendent, George Worden at (shop) 243-2585 or (cell) 750-7528, for details and site review pertaining to a driveway permit.
- 4. A copy of NYS Engineer's stamped plans must accompany the completed Building permit application for buildings with a construction cost of \$20,000 or more.
- 5. A plot plan is required showing location of the structure on the property and distances to other buildings and property lines, for review by the Zoning/Code Enforcement Officer.
- 6. A copy of the contractors' certificate of workers compensation must accompany the application for a building permit.
- 7. Upon submittal of the completed building permit application the Zoning/ Code Enforcement Officer will determine if a house number needs to be issued for the structure.

Once these steps have been followed and approved, the building permit will be issued. The home owner will be contacted for permit fees and pick Up. **Please allow 3 to 4 days for application processing.**
