Section 1. The veterans exemption from real property taxes granted on any real property in the Town of York pursuant to Section 458 of the Real Property Tax Law, shall be increased or decreased in the same proportion as the assessed valuation of such property as has been increased or decreased on the assessment roll to be finally completed and filed in 1980 by reason of real property being assessed at full value on such assessment roll. The adjustment specified in this section shall be made by the assessors only if the assessors implement a revaluation of real property on such assessment roll in compliance with Section 306 of the Real Property Tax Law.

Section 2. This local law shall be subject to a Referendum on Petition and shall take effect upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State, which filing shall occur no less than 45 days after its adoption by the York Town Board.
