Section I. Restriction of Parking.
Beginning one (1) hour after the commencement of any snowfall in the Town of York, and continuing for two days after such snowfall has ended, no vehicles may be parked on Town Highways or roads and any vehicle so parked during such period may be removed therefrom in order to facilitate snow removal operations, as provided below, at the expense of the owner of such vehicle.

Section II. Removal of Vehicles.
The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to remove, at his discretion, any vehicles parked on Town highways in violation of this local law and to make arrangements for the towing and storage of such vehicles as he may, in his discretion, determine, the charges and expenses of which shall be borne solely by the owner or owners of such vehicles.

Section III. Effective Date.
This local law shall take effect immediately upon compliance with all applicable provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
