A local law	Providing for the conduct of Games of Chance (Insert Title)
Be it enacted b	y theof the (Name of Legislative Body)
County City Town Village	York as follows:

- Section I. This local law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Town of York.
- SectionII. "Authorized Organization" shall mean an authorized organization as defined in § 186(4) of the General Municipal Law. "Games of Chance" shall mean a games of chance as defined in § 186(3) of the General Municipal Law.
- SectionIII Authorized organizations may, upon obtaining a license from the Town Clerk, conduct games of chance within the Town of York as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this local law.
- Section IV The conduct of games of chance shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by § 189 of the General Municipal Law.
- Section V. Games of Chance may not be conducted on Sunday pursuant to this local law. Further, no games of chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or New Year's Eve.
- Section VI The Sheriff of Livingston County shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted under duly authorized license. The said Sheriff shall have all those powers and duties set forth in and for the enforcement of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.
- SectionVII This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, following its approval by majority of the qualified voters of the Town of York voting on a proposition therefore, at a special election held pursuant to the provisions of § 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
- SectionVIII This local law may be amended or repealed by a two-thirds vote of the Town Board without further submission for approval by the voters of the Town of York.
