LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2001

WHEREAS, the Town of York and John L. Kellogg have heretofore settled a long-standing lawsuit over ownership of and boundary lines for land constituting a parcel locally known as Fowlerville Square and its contiguous properties; and

WHEREAS, such settlement contained agreements between the parties pertaining to parking restrictions around Fowlerville Square; and

WHEREAS, by such settlement the westerly boundary line of lands owned by the Town of York, constituting Fowlerville Square, is a line described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the northerly highway line of Fowlerville Road N 79° 30' W a distance of 70.81 feet from the intersection of said northerly highway line of Fowlerville Road with the westerly highway boundary of MacIntyre Road; thence N 10° 56' 15" E a distance of 138.00 feet to a point; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of York finds that parking restrictions in that area are required in order to provide for full access to all parcels for fire and other emergency equipment as well as for snow removal and other public safety obligations of the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of York does hereby enact such parking restrictions as follows:

- 1. The terms motor vehicles, farm vehicles, and parking shall be defined as they are defined in the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- 2. There shall be no parking permitted east of the westerly boundary line described above at any time.
- 3. West of said boundary line parking of only currently registered, licensed and inspected motor vehicles, farm vehicles and other farm equipment will be permitted for no more than thirty (30) days at a time. If a vehicle once parked in this area for more than seven (7) days is moved it may not be re-parked in that area for at least thirty (30) days. However, this section shall not apply to any vehicle with current NYS inspection sticker displayed thereon, being offered for sale as indicated by a "For Sale" sign being affixed thereto or a sale price being displayed thereon.
- 4. At the north said of Fowlerville Square, parking of only motor vehicles, including only automobiles, motorcycles and pick-up trucks, shall be permitted in the parcel of land described as follows:

BEGINNING at a PK nail on the assumed westerly highway line of MacIntyre which nail is N 12° 04' 00"E a distance of 165.06 feet from the intersection of said assumed westerly highway line of MacIntyre Road with the assumed northerly highway line of Fowlerville Road; thence N 79° 30 00"W a distance of 48.71 feet to a point; thence N 10° 56' 15" E a distance of 27.00 feet to a point; thence S 79° 30' 00" E a distance of 49.24 feet to a point; thence S 12° 04' 00" W along the assumed westerly highway line of Fowlerville Road a distance of 27.01 feet to the point of beginning.

No parking shall be permitted south of the southerly boundary of the above described parcel.

- 5. Owners and/or operators of vehicles parked in the above described areas shall be jointly and severally responsible for complying with the parking restrictions herein contained.
- 6. A violation of the restrictions herein contained shall constitute an offense and shall be punishable by a fine of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
- 7. Each day that a continuing violation of this local law goes on shall be considered a separate violation hereof.
- 8. Conviction for a second violation by the same defendant of the terms of this local law within one year of the first may be punished by a fine of up to three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and conviction for a third or greater violation by the same defendant may be punishable by a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).
