LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2015

OF THE TOWN OF YORK

A local law to amend the zoning map and Article IV of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York, Livingston County, New York, to extend the boundaries of the Hamlet Commercial District (HC) and reduce the boundaries of the Commercial District (C).

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of York as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND SCOPE

This local law shall be known as "A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP AND ARTICLE IV OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF YORK, LIVINGSTON COUNTY, NEW YORK TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE HAMLET COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (HC) AND REDUCE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (C)."

SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to modify the boundaries of certain zoning districts whereby certain properties that are currently zoned as being part of a Commercial District (C) under §405 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York shall be re-classified to Hamlet Commercial District (HC) under §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York.

The intent of the proposed changes is to:

- 1. Balance various forms of use and development that are desirable by the public while protecting the rural character of the Town;
- 2. Protect property values by permitting uses, buildings and structures that are compatible with the character of the Town; and
- 3. Minimize conflicts among the various land uses, both now and in the future.

SECTION 3. LOCATION OF MODIFIED ZONING DESIGNATION.

The existing Commercial Zoning District located along the west side of Main Street (also known as NYS Route 36) from its point of intersection with the northerly right-of-way line of Genesee Street (also known as NYS Route 63), northerly to the south right-of-way line of Virginia Avenue, in the Town of York, Livingston County New York, which said area contains five (5) tax parcels, shall be and are hereby re-classified, modified and changed as follows:

Tax Identifier Map Parcel Number 60.20-1-24.12 shall be reclassified to Hamlet

Commercial District (HC) as described and authorized by §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York;

Tax Identifier Map Parcel Number 60.20-1-20.1 shall be reclassified to Hamlet Commercial District (HC) as described and authorized by §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York;

Tax Identifier Map Parcel Number 60.20-1-19 shall be reclassified to Hamlet Commercial District (HC) as described and authorized by §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York;

Tax Identifier Map Parcel Number 60.20-1-18 shall be reclassified to Hamlet Commercial District (HC) as described and authorized by §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York; and

Tax Identifier Map Parcel Number 60.20-1-17 shall be reclassified to Hamlet Commercial District (HC) as described and authorizeded by §404 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of York.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT OF EXISTING ZONING MAP TO REFLECT CHANGES.

The official Zoning Map of the Town of York shall be amended to reflect the changes effectuated hereunder.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall be effective immediately upon its filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.
