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TOWN OF YORK LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2016

A local law providing for the appointment of Alternate Members of the Planning Board and Alternate Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of York as follows:

Section 1: Short Title and Applicability

This local law shall apply to the appointment, terms, functions and powers of alternate members appointed to serve on the Planning Board and on the Zoning Board of Appeals in the Town of York.

Section 2: Declaration of Policy

It is sometimes difficult to maintain a quorum on the Town of York Planning Board and the Town of York Zoning Board of Appeals because members are ill, on extended vacation or find they have a conflict of interest situation on a specific matter before such board. In such instances, official business cannot be conducted which may delay or impede adherence to required timelines. The use of alternate members in such instances is hereby authorized pursuant to the provisions of this local law.

Section 3: Definitions

"Planning Board" means the planning board of the Town of York as established by the Town Board of the Town of York by local law or ordinance, pursuant to the provisions of § 271 of the Town Law and §239-c of the General Municipal Law.

"Zoning Board of Appeals" means the zoning board of appeals of the Town of York as established by the Town Board of the Town of York by local law or ordinance, pursuant to the provisions of § 267 of the Town Law and §239-c of the General Municipal Law.

"Member" means an individual appointed by the Town Board to serve on the Town of York Planning Board or the Town of York Zoning Board of Appeals pursuant to the provisions of the local law or ordinance which first established such planning board.

"Alternate Member" means an individual appointed by the Town Board to serve on the Town of York Planning Board or the Town of York Zoning Board of Appeals when a regular member is unable to participate on an application or matter before the board, as provided herein.

Section 4: Authorization/Effect

The Town of York hereby enacts this local law to provide a process for appointing alternate members of the Town of York Planning Board and the Town of York Zoning Board of

Appeals. These individuals would serve when members are absent or unable to participate on an application or matter before the board.

Alternate Members of the Planning Board shall be appointed by the Town Board for a term of three (3) years.

The chairperson of the Planning Board may designate an Alternate Member to substitute for a member when such member is absent or unable to participate on an application or matter before the Planning Board. When so designated, the Alternate Member shall possess all the powers and responsibilities of such member of the board. Such designation shall be entered into the minutes of the initial Planning Board meeting at which the substitution is made.

All provisions of state law relating to planning board member eligibility, vacancy in office, removal, compatibility of office and service on other boards, as well as any provisions of a local law/local ordinance relating to training, continuing education, compensation and attendance, shall also apply to Alternate Members.

Alternate Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals shall be appointed by the Town Board for a term of three (3) years.

The chairperson of the Zoning Board of Appeals may designate an Alternate Member to substitute for a member when such member is absent or unable to participate on an application or matter before the Zoning Board of Appeals. When so designated, the Alternate Member shall possess all the powers and responsibilities of such member of the board. Such designation shall be entered into the minutes of the initial Zoning Board of Appeals meeting at which the substitution is made.

All provisions of state law relating to zoning board of appeals member eligibility, vacancy in office, removal, compatibility of office and service on other boards, as well as any provisions of a local law/local ordinance relating to training, continuing education, compensation and attendance, shall also apply to Alternate Members.

Section 5. Supersession of Town Law

This local law is hereby adopted pursuant to the provisions of §10 of the NYS Municipal Home Rule Law and §10 of the NYS Statute of Local Governments. It is the intent of the Town Board, pursuant to §10 of the NYS Municipal Home Rule Law, to supersede the provisions of §\$271 and 267 of the Town Law and §239-c of the General Municipal Law relating to the appointment of members to the Town of York Planning Board and the Town of York Zoning Board of Appeals.

Section 6. Severability

If any provisions of this local law are held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the local law shall remain in effect.

Section 7. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
